## Pumpkin Muffins Recipe

These one-bowl muffins are a fall baking essential.

Prep time 15 minutes

Cook time 25 minutes to 30 minutes

Makes 12

### Ingredients

- Cooking spray or paper muffin liners
- 1 (15-ounce) can pumpkin purée (not pumpkin pie filling)
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup neutral oil, such as canola or vegetable oil
- 2 large eggs
- 1 tablespoon [pumpkin pie spice](#)
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour

### Instructions

1. Heat the oven to 375°F. Line a standard 12-well muffin pan with paper liners or coat the wells with cooking spray.
2. Whisk 1 (15-ounce) can pumpkin purée, 3/4 cup granulated sugar, 1/2 cup neutral oil, 2 large eggs, 1 tablespoon pumpkin pie spice, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon vanilla extract, and 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt together in a large bowl until combined and smooth.
3. Add 1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour and fold it in with a flexible spatula until just incorporated but no dry spots remain. Divide the batter evenly among the muffin wells (about 1/3 cup per well); the wells will be almost full.
4. Bake, rotating the pan halfway through, until the muffins are golden-brown, the tops bounce back when pressed, and a tester inserted into the center of a muffin comes out clean, 25 to 30 minutes total. Let the muffins cool in the pan for 5 minutes, then transfer to a wire rack and let cool completely.

### Recipe Notes

**Storage:** The muffins can be stored in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 3 days. They can also be individually wrapped in plastic wrap and frozen for up to 2 months. Thaw at room temperature.

5. Election of Officers 2024
  - a. President and Secretary positions are open this year for nomination/election.
  - b. Nominations will begin today, with voting in November. The job descriptions were distributed for members to review.

6. Show and Tell: thank you for bringing your beautiful creations to share!
7. Community Center donation quilt: Diane donated quilt top, Debbie donated backing, Beth quilted it, Lisa will bind.
8. Tips and Tricks –
  - a. Favorite rulers and feet to share – Chris shared favorite longarm feet:
    - cup foot/scoop foot – works well with T-shirt quilts to avoid bumps, double batting quilts, thick quilts like denim
    - discussion on how to change longarm feet
    - discussion on chenille foot
    - ruffling foot
    - Rulers by Sew Steady, Four Pods Quilting, guide with holding posts, Quilter's Groove, QCR, Log Cabin Trim Tool by Creative Grids, The Angler.
  - b. Beth reviewed tips from a judge's point of view:
    - Bindings can make or break the quilt
    - Quilting
    - Enter a clean quilt – no pet hair, no markings, no stray threads, etc.

9. Quilt Show ribbons: total of 54 ribbons to award. There will be a winner and honorable for each category. Centers were purchased wherein we can print our center with INMQ name and year.
10. Challenges –
- a. Status of Treasure Challenge - napkin projects - Blocks given via WSQ Charity for next year's challenge.
