Treasure Quilt Challenge/Machine Quilting Challenge/Sharpie Block – Anita Pederson

- There are a few kits left. \$15. fee.
- Machine Quilt Challenge- \$15 fee. This is about how quilting changes the look.
- Sharpie block exchange and book - printed 10 sets for volunteers use. Printing book is expensive. Archiving old books to flash drives for sale may have a security problem with unauthorized copying.
- Blue star winner's block is put on cover. Extending deadline for block submission to November.
- Demonstration of how to make block using dry erase or erasable markers. One of every block equals a free book. Bring in blocks by November.

Art salvage is a resource for threads. Prize money for first is \$500.
